

Pan London –African HIV Health Promotion Knowledge and Skills Development course

The **African HIV Health Promotion Knowledge and Skills Development courses** are aimed at supporting health promotion workers to understand the context and the full range of evidence based interventions used to meet the HIV prevention needs of Africans in London.

Part 1: Health Promotion Skills 1 day courses over a 3 week period

Locations:

Kensington and Chelsea, Tottenham, East London and Mitcham.

Content:

Week 1: Module 1: HIV prevention needs of Africans in the UK.

Week 2: Module 2: The range of health promotion interventions

Week 3: Module 3 and 4:

Morning session:

Barriers to accessing sexual health services

Afternoon session:

Current and emerging prevention technologies

Successful applicants will be informed of the exact training dates and times for the chosen locations.

Part 2: Developing the Sexual Health Trainer (OCN accredited)

Please note This course will only be available to participants who have attended all 4 Health Promotion Skills Development Modules.

Location Central London

Content:

Day 1: is a taught component, delivered with 2 facilitators.

Day 2: participants are required to deliver a 10 minute sexual health presentation to their peers.

Assignment: feedback session and assignment to be completed within one month of delivery.

Certificates are issued upon successful completion of all three elements. Travel cost and OCN fees are covered.
